¹The fees were first collected for fall semester '91 (FY92) to support computer technology. At this time, there were many course fees being charged to support computer technology. Discussion with GSB and GSS led to a resolution and their support of a student computer fee. At the same time, the Board of Regents removed the course fees to smooth the costs out. The fees were the same for FY92, FY93 and FY94. A Fiscal Year includes the summer, fall and spring semesters.

²In FY95, MIS asked for an incremental fee for their majors. This was on top of the standard fee. In FY08 this fee was transitioned to a Business College fee.

³Graduate Students paying the Standard fee started paying 80% in FY02.

⁴MIS fee replaced by Business fee (Standard + \$20) in FY08

⁵Computer Science fee to match Engineering fee starting in FY09

⁶Up until FY02, small increases in fees were recognized. Between that time and FY10, nominal increases (generally consistent with HEPI) have been recognized.

⁷There are three units that have higher fees than the standard and the difference goes back to those units.
